## Start a Degree Program

Train for ministry through church-based theological education programs from an accredited academic institution.

## Start a Certificate of Ministry Program

Earn undergraduate or graduate credit for basic leadership development training in your church.

The Certificate of Ministry programs allow church members to start their theological education in your church or supplement programs at other institutions with credit earned for training in your church. Students may enroll at low Antioch School tuition rates and transfer credit to programs of other institutions or apply the credit to full Antioch School degree programs.

## Earn Credit for Individual Courses

Students may earn academic credit in their own churches in advance of enrolling in degree programs of the Antioch School or other academic institutions.

Students may transfer credit into programs in which they are already enrolled. Credit may be earned at the undergraduate or graduate levels.

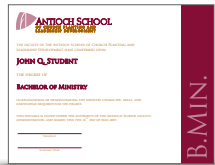

Students post evidence of their competencies, and local leaders use the system to assess development and provide initial approval of competencies. Antioch School Associate Faculty members also assess evidence for each item in the portfolio transcripts in order to validate competencies and grant credit to students.
